## **Suction Bathroom Grab Rail IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

Use only after thoroughly reading instructions.

Incorrect use can result in serious personal injury.

## **PRECAUTIONS:**

The Suction Bathroom Grab Rail is not designed to hold or support total body weight. It is only designed to assist with your natural motion whilst moving around the bathroom.

- Always be aware of your ability and limitations in strength and range of movement.
- **DO NOT** attach to moving surfaces, such as sliding or hinged glass doors.
- **ALWAYS** check the strength of suctions before use.
- Suction Bathroom Grab Rail will lose suction over time and should be re-set weekly.
- **DO NOT** attach over tile grout lines, embossed tiles, or uneven surfaces.

## ATTACHING THE SUCTION GRAB BAR:

- 1. Suction Bathroom Grab Rail is designed for use only on smooth and non-porous surfaces, such as tiles, glass, porcelain or fibreglass. **DO NOT USE** on plaster board, wood, painted or papered surfaces.
- 2. DO NOT attach to tiled surfaces where grout lines are spaced apart by 10cm or less. The suction WILL NOT work over grout lines.
- 3. Check the condition of the surface before positioning the Suction Bathroom Grab Rail. Support surface should be free of defects and be in sound condition.
- 4. Clean surfaces thoroughly and allow to completely dry before attaching the Suction Bathroom Grab Rail.
- 5. **NEVER** attach to surfaces that have residual soap scum or mould.
- 6. **NEVER** mount in a position where Suction Grab Rail is in direct sunlight.

Always check the condition of the suction cups. DO NOT use if damaged.

## **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. With the 3 levers raised, place suction cups so they are firmly and completely on a smooth surface. **DO NOT** attach to mosaic tiles or over grout lines.
- 2. Hold and push Suction Bathroom Grab Rail firmly against the surface, then flip the levers closed. You should feel resistance as the suction tightens against the surface.
- 3. Always check attachments before each use, and regularly clean the suctions with a non-abrasive alcohol based bathroom cleaner.
- 4. To remove, lift all the levers to disengage suction. If suction remains, lift one edge with a finger. DO NOT use a sharp edge as this will impair suction capacity and future use.
